

Uniform Policy

In order to promote a safe and orderly environment focused on learning, the following uniform policy has been adopted by the Riley High School parents and faculty. Students who fail to follow the uniform policy may be given detentions, Saturday School, or excluded from extracurricular activities, but may not be barred from attending class. A student may receive additional consequences for violating the uniform policy if the student's dress disrupts or may disrupt the educational process. For example, a student may receive a consequence for wearing clothing or accessories that display gang affiliation.

The Riley High School Uniform will consist of:

- A. Clothing must fit as designed, not oversized or too snug.
 - a. No sagging.
 - b. Ripped, torn, shredded or snagged clothing is NOT permitted.
 - c. Modifying clothing in any way is NOT permitted.
- B. Your ID is part of your uniform and must be worn and visible at all times.
- C. Riley spirit wear shirts.
 - a. Must be a RHS shirt in approved colors.
 - i. Blue, yellow/gold, black, white and gray.
 - b. Does not have to be worn over a collared shirt.
- D. Short or long sleeved Polo Shirt with a collar or a collared dress shirt.
 - a. Students may select any solid colored shirt from the approved colors:
 - i. Blue, yellow/gold, black, white or gray.
- E. Solid cardigans, sweaters, or sweatshirts may be worn in the following colors:
 - a. Blue, yellow/gold, black, white or gray.
 - b. Hooded garments are NOT permitted. NO HOODIES!
- F. Pants, slacks and skirts must be navy, khaki, or black.
 - a. Shorts and capris' (No knit or fleece material) may be worn from April 1 through October 30.
 - b. Cargo pants will be allowed this school year.
 - c. Leggings or joggers are NOT permitted.
 - d. Spandex/yoga pants are NOT permitted.
 - e. Jeans/denim (of any color) are NOT permitted at any time.
- G. Shoes and sneakers must be closed toe and closed heels. NO EXCEPTIONS!
 - a. No slide-ons, flip-flops, slippers, moccasins, or sport sandals of any kind.

- H. Skirts and shorts should be no shorter than three inches below the fingertips and/or three inches above the knees.
- I. No bare midriffs, tank tops, or tube tops of any kind, nor can they be worn over the polo or dress shirt.
- J. Athletic teams or clubs will be limited to an approved jersey or team/club shirt only on the day of an event.
 - a. No hoodies or sweatpants are allowed. Prior approval is required.

The following are NOT permitted to be worn to school:

- revealing or suggestive clothing
- saggy pants or clothing that reveals/displays undergarments
- clothing & jewelry containing messages or images about alcohol, drugs, tobacco, violence, cults, racism, profanity, gang membership, or sexual content
- hats, bandannas, sweatbands, hairnets, “do rags”, headscarves
- blue jeans, leggings, pajamas, boxer shorts, biker shorts, micro mini-skirts, short shorts (shorts & skirts must be three inches (3”) below fingertips), pants with holes
- sunglasses, chains, spikes, gloves
- slippers
- Other items or styles that are not in the spirit of the uniform policy or that draw undue attention to a student or cause distractions to the educational environment.
